The new director will have the opportunity to shape the future of the Center as it seeks to enhance its tradition of radical interdisciplinarity and build new local and international publics through its events, publications, and on-line presence. Candidates should have a record of interdisciplinarity, scholarly distinction commensurate with a tenured faculty appointment, and experience in intellectual leadership and program development. We are especially interested in applicants with interdisciplinary breadth, internationally recognized scholarship, a significant record of leadership in an academic setting, and a demonstrated commitment to faculty research and intellectual community on and beyond campus.
