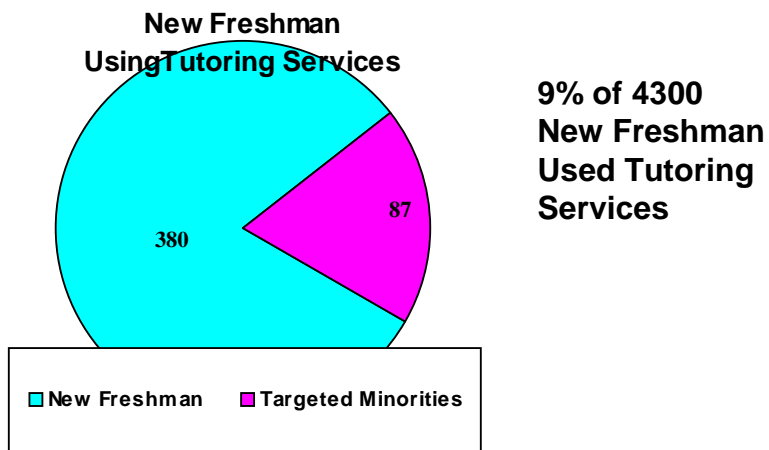
Goals: Tutoring Implementation Group

Collecting and Assessing Data Over Time

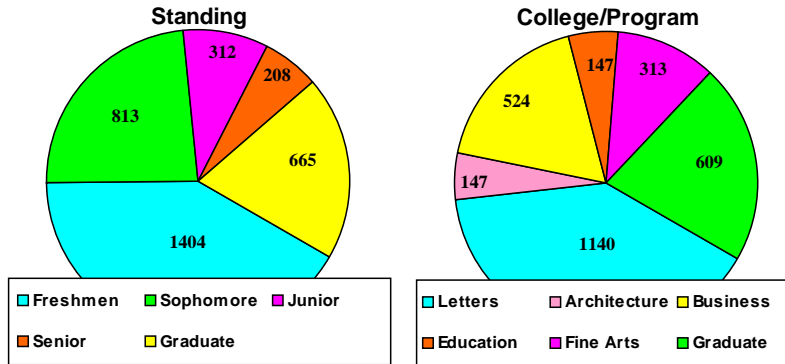
Example: Writing Center Fall 2004 -2005

86%	Of all English 095, 101, and 102, those who earned a C or better
95%	Of those students who visited the Writing Center once, those who earned a C or better
99%	Of those students who visited the Writing Center more than once, those who earned a C or better
