NCA evidence statements

1. The University's academic and student support programs contribute to the development of student skills and attitudes fundamental to responsible use of knowledge.
Survey of departments for course content
Undergraduate research
2. The University follows explicit policies and procedures to ensure ethical conduct in its research and instructional activities (Team I, integrity)
3. The University provides effective oversight and support services to ensure the integrity of research and practice conducted by its faculty and students.
4. Synthesis of 2 and 3: The University follows explicit policies and procedures and provides effective oversight and support services to ensure ethical conduct and integrity in its research and instructional activities
University reporting of outside financial activities
5. The University encourages curricular and co-curricular activities that relate responsible use of knowledge to practicing social responsibility.

6. The University creates, disseminates, and enforces clear policies on practices involving intellectual property rights.
