Of the 1,906 respondents, 84.7% identified themselves as White, 4.4% were African American, 2.9% were Latino/a, 1.9% were Asian, .6% were American Indian, 2.2% were Southeast Asian, .9% were Multi-Ethnic, .6% were International, .1% identified themselves as of "Other" Race, and 1.6% did not supply that information.
