

GRADUATING SENIOR SURVEY Spring 2011- Summary of All Respondents

Of the 2,005 respondents, 85.6% identified themselves as White, 3.3% were African American, 1.4% were Latino/a, 1.6% were Asian, .3% were American Indian, 1.8% were Southeast Asian, 4.8% were Multi-Ethnic, 1.0% were International, .0% identified themselves as of "Other" Race, and .1% did not supply that information.

65.6% reported UWM as being their first choice of university, while 34.4% reported no.

79.4% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 20.6% said no.

16.7% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

45.3% reported living on campus, 54.7% reported living off campus.
