I had an extremely negative learning experience during nursing clinicals. My instructor, on top of essentially refusing to teach my group anything, was verbally abusive, dishonest, and threatening. Several members of the faculty turned a deaf ear after we pleaded for a chance to discuss our situation. Considering how many times I've heard that the faculty was here to help, I felt abandoned and silenced. I think that the College of Nursing needs to improve based on student feedback, and my experience in the nursing program was sub-par at times

I would attend the Oshkosh program because the nursing program format is much better in my eyes.

I would have just finished my initial degree at the first university that I attended. I was required to take many classes over because certain classes were not accepted by UWM from other UW universities. The amount of time for the Capstone was difficult to complete during the day when working Monday thru Friday

The price was right but after speaking with students in other nursing programs I felt UWM could have done a better job in preparing me for a nursing career and giving information to enrichment programs outside of school such as internships. Although there are a few outstanding faculty I feel there was disorganization among many of the faculty. I believe there needs to be more parallels in the coursework with the clinical study. There also should be more time allotted to studying the information that will be pertinent to nursing such as drugs and disease process rather than so much of an emphasis on research and community wellness.

The UWWC program needs to be improved. The clinical sites are not always the best. Also, I feel there is a severe lack of communication from school to student. Email is NOT always the best option for big changes in requirements for entry to the next semester. Communication efforts must be improved.
