

# SPRING 2013 GRADUATING SENIOR SURVEY SUMMARY

## All Respondents

Of the 2,085 respondents, 80.8% identified themselves as White, 4.9% were African American, 2.3% were Latino/a, 2.0% were Asian American, 0.4% were American Indian, 2.4% were Southeast Asian, 5.6% were Multi-Ethnic, 1.6% were International, 0.0% identified themselves as an "Other" Race, and 0.0% did not supply that information.

66.2% reported UWM as being their first choice of university, while 33.8% reported UWM was not their first choice.

79.2% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 20.8% said they did not.

18.9% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

47.0% reported living on campus, 53.0% reported living off campus.

# SPRING 2013 GRADUATING SENIOR SURVEY SUMMARY

## Male Respondents

Of the 1022 respondents, 81.7% identified themselves as White, 4.8% were African American, 2.5% were Latino/a, 1.6% were Asian American, 0.2% were American Indian, 2.3% were Southeast Asian, 5.1% were Multi-Ethnic, 1.9% were International, 0.0% identified themselves as an "Other" Race, and 0.0% did not supply that information.

69.1% reported UWM as being their first choice of university, while 30.9% reported UWM was not their first choice.

80.2% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 19.8% said they did not.

21.6% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

46.6% reported living on campus, 53.4% reported living off campus.

83.2% reported their plans for the next 1-2 years include full-time employment, 17.0% part-time employment, 4.9% military service, 28.8% graduate/professional school, 9.5% other continuing education, 12.7% volunteer activity, and 3.3% had other plans.

Of those planning on graduate school, 35.2% reported considering UWM, 22.5% said no, and 42.3% were unsure.
