After completing my undergrad at UWM there is no guarantee that I will be accepted into a physical therapy program. The feeling of not knowing makes me a little uneasy, I should have done my research about the program before switching majors.

Financial reasons and costs of living.

It is too expensive to live around here.

Advisors and professors at the university are sub-par and were not helpful in establishing my degree.

The quality of education is less than that of my previous undergraduate experience at UW-Madison and UW Hospital. Instructors were not as knowledgeable as I expected and were, at times, unprofessional when dealing with appropriately addressed concerns. I have an expectation that because I am paying for an education my questions will be answered in a timely manner, my exams will be graded appropriately and mistakes will be acknowledged and remedied. That said, the online course offerings were appropriate for my needs and were

To hard to get into the classes for my major and didn't offer full time financial aid for the summer courses that are required for my senior year of my program.
