All Respondents

Of the 1909 respondents, 81.5% identified themselves as White, 3.6% were African American, 1.9% were Latino/a, 1.6% were Asian American, 0.6% were American Indian, 3.2% were Southeast Asian, 5.2% were Multi-Ethnic, 2.2% were International, and 0.2% did not supply that information.

65.1% reported UWM as being their first choice of university, while 34.9% reported UWM was not their first choice.

77.1% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 22.9% said they did not.

16.9% stopped out for one or more semesters.

44.8% reported living on campus, 55.2% reported living off campus.
