All Respondents

Of the 1882 respondents, 78.6% identified themselves as White, 5.9% were African American, 2.2% were Latino/a, 2.1% were Asian American, 0.4% were American Indian, 2.4% were Southeast Asian, 6.2% were Multi-Ethnic, 2.1% were International, and 0.2% did not supply that information.

66.3% reported UWM as being their first choice of university, while 33.7% reported UWM was not their first choice.

77.7% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 22.3% said they did not.

18% stopped out for one or more semesters.

48.5% reported living on campus, 51.5% reported living off campus.

68% reported their plans for the next 1-2 years include full-time employment, 4.6% part-time employment, 0.9% military service, 21.5% graduate/professional school, 0.9% other continuing education, 1.4% volunteer activity, and 2.8% had other plans.
