

MAY, 2005 GRADUATING SENIOR SURVEY

All Respondents - Summary

Questionnaires were taken by 1637 seniors. Of the respondents:

85.5% identified themselves as [White](#), 5.3% were [African American](#), 3.5% were [Latino/Hispanic](#), 2.2% were [Asian/Pacific Islander](#), 0.6% were [American Indian/Alaska Native](#), 1.7% were [Southeast Asian](#), and 1.2% were [Not Applicable \(used for international students\)](#).

58.8% reported UWM as being their [first choice](#) of university, while 41.2% reported [no](#).

65.6% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 34.4% said [no](#).

20.1% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

39.1% reported living [on campus](#), 60.9% reported living [off campus](#).

80.5% reported their plans for the next 1-2 years include full-time employment, 16.3% part-time employment, 2.3% military service, 50.9% graduate/professional school, 12.5% other continuing education, 7% other.

Of those planning on graduate school, 44% reported considering UWM, 25.4% said [no](#), and 30.6% were [unsure](#).
