

MAY, 2006 GRADUATING SENIOR SURVEY

All Respondents - Summary

Questionnaires were taken by 1636 seniors. Of the respondents:

87.5% identified themselves as [White](#), 4.3% were [African American](#), 2.3% were [Latino/Hispanic](#), 1.9% were [Asian/Pacific Islander](#), 0.7% were [American Indian/Alaska Native](#), 1.7% were [Southeast Asian](#), and 1.5% were [Not Applicable \(used for international students\)](#).

61.1% reported UWM as being their [first choice](#) of university, while 38.9% reported [no](#).

70.3% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 29.7% said [no](#).

17.1% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

40.6% reported living [on campus](#), 59.4% reported living [off campus](#).

80.1% reported their plans for the next 1-2 years include full-time employment, 14% part-time employment, 1.7% military service, 49.3% graduate/professional school, 12.3% other continuing education, 0% other.

Of those planning on graduate school, 41.9% reported considering UWM, 23.5% said [no](#), and 34.6% were [unsure](#).

Summary for Respondents Identifying themselves as Female

61.8% reported UWM as being their first choice of university, while 38.2% reported no.

68.1% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 31.9% said no.

15.9% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

40% reported living on campus, 60% reported living off campus.

Of those planning on graduate school, 42.3% reported considering UWM, 25.5% said no, and 32.3% were unsure.
