

GRADUATING SENIOR SURVEY SPRING 2007

All Respondents – Summary

Questionnaires were taken by 1677 seniors. Of the respondents:

86.2% identified themselves as [White](#), 4.4% were [African American](#), 3.4% were [Latino/Hispanic](#), 1.8% were [Asian/Pacific Islander](#), 0.6% were [American Indian/Alaska Native](#), 1.7% were [Southeast Asian](#), and 1.8% were [Not Applicable \(used for international students\)](#).

61.7% reported UWM as being their [first choice](#) of university, while 38.3% reported [no](#).

72.2% reported feeling a sense of commitment to and involvement with UWM, 27.8% said [no](#).

17.7% "stopped out" for one or more semesters.

42.6% reported living [on campus](#), 57.4% reported living [off campus](#).

79.1% reported their plans for the next 1-2 years include full-time employment, 16.4% part-time employment, 1.5% military service, 52.4% graduate/professional school, 12.3% other continuing education, 6.6% other.

Of those planning on graduate school, 59.8% reported considering UWM, 18.6% said [no](#), and 21.5% were unsure.
