Starting on Oct. 16, a weekly log of submitted comments will be included on the master plan website. Each person submitting comments is being asked "Would you like your comments to be posted online for others to read?" Those answering "yes" will have their comments posted. All submitted comments, regardless of the answer to the question, will be shared with the Campus Planning Steering Committee and Coordinating Committee, and the Campus Master Plan consultants.

The deadline to submit comments is 11:59 p.m. Nov. 9, 2009
