- Full time Business Freshman or Sophomore, or Full time Junior or Senior admitted and enrolled in the Lubar School of Business
- Preference for Freshmen
- African American
- Resident of the City of Milwaukee at time of application
- Academic achievement in high school

- Demonstrated financial need
- Good character, which may be evidenced by nomination from the Education Committee of the Milwaukee Innercity Congregations Allied for Hope (MICAHA) or by letter of recommendation from MICAHA or one of its member congregations
- Renewable for recipients continuing to meet criteria as outlined in their award letters

### Jerry Leer Advanced Accounting Scholarships

*Varying award numbers and amounts*

- Accounting major/program
- Full-time Junior, Senior, or Graduate student
- Graduate students must have completed at least 50% of degree credits
- Academic achievement (min. 3.5 overall GPA in business and accounting coursework)
- Grade of “B” or better in Intermediate Accounting, and at least 30 credits completed at UWM
- Overall academic performance in accounting courses
- Financial need may be considered
- Involvement in extracurricular activities considered

### Leer/Tellier Scholarships

*Varying award numbers and amounts*

- Accounting major
- Full-time Junior, Senior or Graduate student
- Completion of at least two advanced accounting courses beyond Intermediate Accounting
- Undergraduates: at least 30 credits completed at UWM
- Financial need may be considered
- Involvement in extracurricular activities considered

### Lubar Scholarships

*Multiple awards at varying amounts*

- Business major
- Newly admitted Undergraduate or Graduate students
- Academic achievement
- Not limited to those demonstrating financial need
- May be renewable

### Manpower Scholarships for Workforce of Tomorrow

*Two awards at \$2500*

- Business major
- Student with a permanent mental or physical impairment which substantially limits one or more activities as determined by UWM Student Accessibility Center.

### James H. March Scholarship

*One award at \$4,000*

- Accounting major

### McKendry Cultural Exchange Scholarship

*One award at \$5,000*

- Business major
- Junior or Senior
- Academic achievement
- Used for study abroad in Tokyo, Japan at Sophia University during the summer semester

### Pat and Jerry Moriarity Scholarship

*One award at \$3,000*

- Accounting or Finance major
- Full-time Sophomore
- Academic achievement (min 3.0 cum GPA)
- Financial need
- U.S. citizen graduated from Wisconsin high school
- May be renewable

### Multistate Corporate Tax Guide Scholarship

*One award at \$2,000*

- Enrollment in the SALT Certificate Program or the Masters in Taxation
- Completion of at least one SALT Course with a grade of B or better
- Intent to complete the SALT Certificate Program
- Overall GPA average of at least a 3.0

### Thomas Perz Accounting Scholarship

*One award at \$2,500*

- Graduate student in good standing in the MS Accounting or MS Professional Accounting program
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Minimum grade of “B” in Intermediate Accounting
- Preference for student working to provide financial support for own education

### Kirk Petshek Memorial Scholarship

*One award at \$500*

- Business major
- Student with a physical disability who is pursuing a degree within the Lubar School of Business (students with disabilities other than physical will be considered).
