  - New Non-Student Families & School-Age "Summer Only" Non-Student Families: \$40.00
  - Continuing Families: \$10.00 per Semester
- ◆ Full-Time Full-Year / Kindergarten Program Deposit: One Full Month
- ◆ Schedule Change Fee: \$5.00 per Change
- ◆ "Extra Time" rate: \$2.00 per Half-Day, \$1.00 per After-School Day
- ◆ Escort Fee: \$25.00 per Month
- ◆ Field trip/Activity fees: Actual Cost of Trip or Activity
- ◆ Late Payment Penalty: \$10.00 per Month
- ◆ Sign-In/Sign-Out Penalty: \$5.00 per Occurrence
