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# Certificate in Nutrition

The Certificate in Nutrition may be awarded to eligible students concurrently with their bachelor's degree, to students who have previously received a bachelor's degree at UWM or another accredited institution and to all other students who are eligible for admission to UWM.

The Nutrition Certificate Program offers students and human services professionals in the community a complement to their primary academic discipline. The Nutrition Certificate Program will provide focused education on human nutrition and its relationship to wellness and the disease process. The application of this knowledge is designed promote a healthier population in our community. The specialized study of human nutrition enhances the education of human service providers such as allied health professionals, nurses, social workers, health educators, public community & health specialists, as well as persons in general public who have an interest in wellness and disease prevention.

To receive the certificate students must complete all of the following courses and obtain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in these specific courses. At least one half of the total credits required must be taken at UW-Milwaukee.
