Community Outreach Small Grants Program
Guidelines

OBJECTIVE

The Center for Latin American and Caribbean Studies (CLACS), University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, will offer up to 3 community outreach grants annually (range: \$500-\$1500) in order to encourage Latin American / Caribbean activities beyond campus.* The small grants are intended as a way to enrich Latin American studies within the Milwaukee community and to help build a community resource base for future programming and collaborations.

ELIGIBILITY

Arts, cultural, or community organizations or K-12 schools within the Milwaukee metropolitan area are eligible to apply. Outreach grants are intended for non-university organizations with limited resources. In rare instances, individuals may be eligible, if the proposed activity has a demonstrable local outreach dimension. Priority will be given to new applicants.

TO APPLY

To apply, submit: 1) the attached application; 2) a 1-page (maximum) description of the proposed activity; and 3) a brief activity budget. In particular, please note value of activity for strengthening the Milwaukee community's understanding of Latin America or the Caribbean.

DEADLINES

Requests will be considered on an ongoing basis. It is suggested, however, that proposals be submitted at least 2 months prior to a scheduled event, to allow time for review and to initiate payment, if successful.
