

Who's Training Milwaukee's Future Builders? Race/Ethnicity of Construction Trade Apprentices in the Milwaukee Area

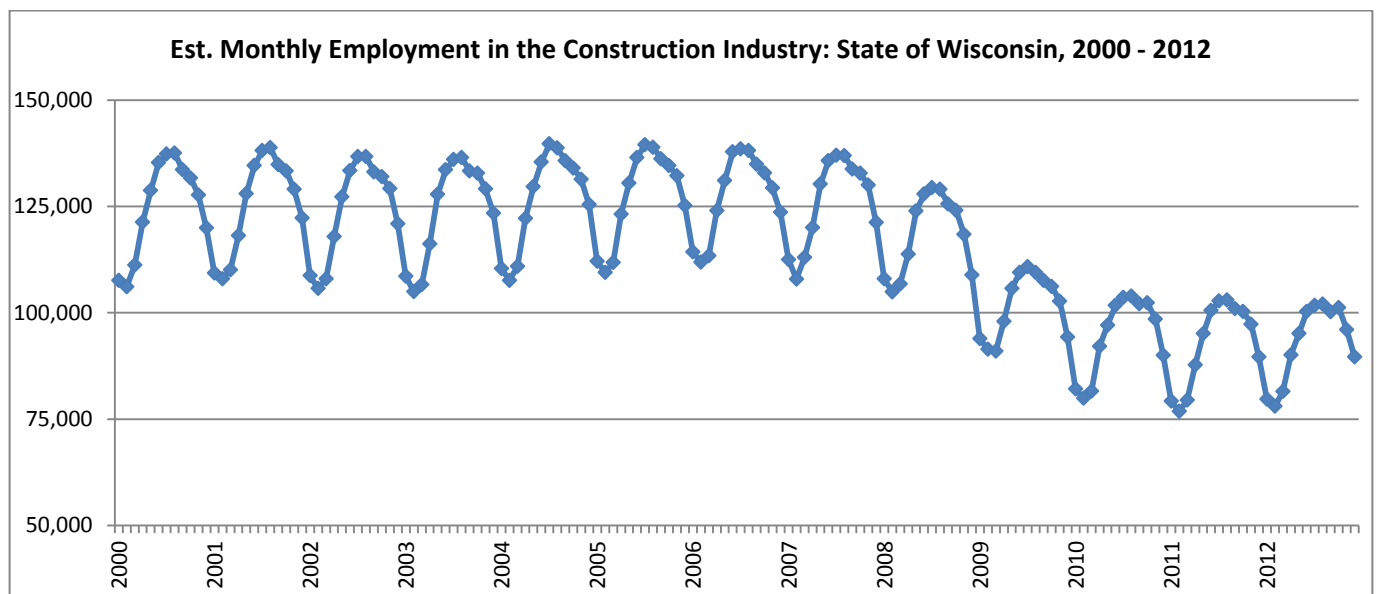
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This report provides racial/ethnicity and gender data on apprentices by construction trade joint apprenticeship committee (JAC), based on data from the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards (BAS).¹ Part One examines hiring patterns of 15 union joint apprenticeship committees serving the Milwaukee area with report cards provided for 217 contractors with apprentices. Part Two identifies the apprentice levels sponsored by 120 union contractors through the statewide Wisconsin Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee. Part Three analyzes the apprenticeship patterns for 81 non-union contractors with apprentices through the Associated Builders & Contractors of WI-Waukesha Joint Apprenticeship Committee.

It is recognized that it is very difficult for companies to hire and train apprentices while their experienced workers are on lay-off or only employed part-time. At the same time, there is a public interest in supporting training for the future construction industry workforce and in investments in increased participation of minorities, and particularly African American and Latino males, in the construction industry.

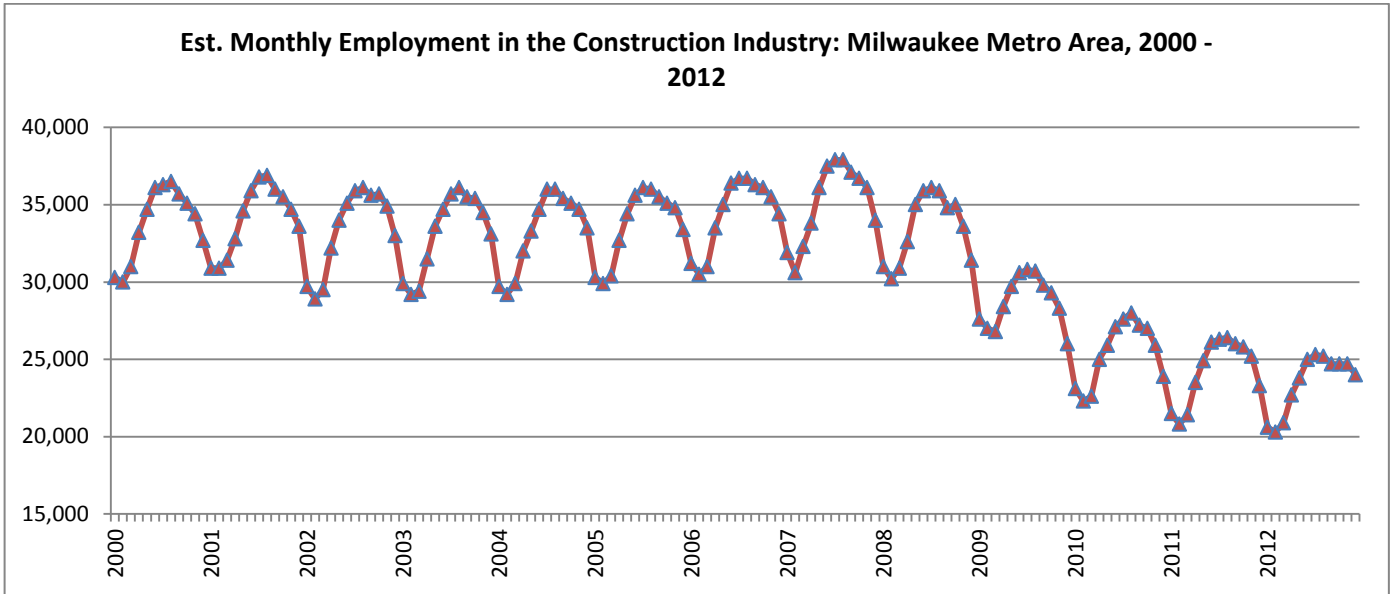
The construction industry continues to suffer substantial job losses as the nation, state, and local communities recover from both the economic recession and the housing crisis impacting the industry. In addition to typical seasonal job fluctuations (with highest employment in the summer months and large-scale layoffs of workers during the January to March period), the industry has shown substantial employment declines in recent years.

The graphs below show estimated monthly employment totals in the construction industry for the state and Milwaukee metro area, based on the Bureau of Labor Statistics CES (Current Employment Statistics) Survey. Statewide, the estimated number of workers employed by construction firms dropped from 137,000 in July 2007 to 78,000 in February 2012.

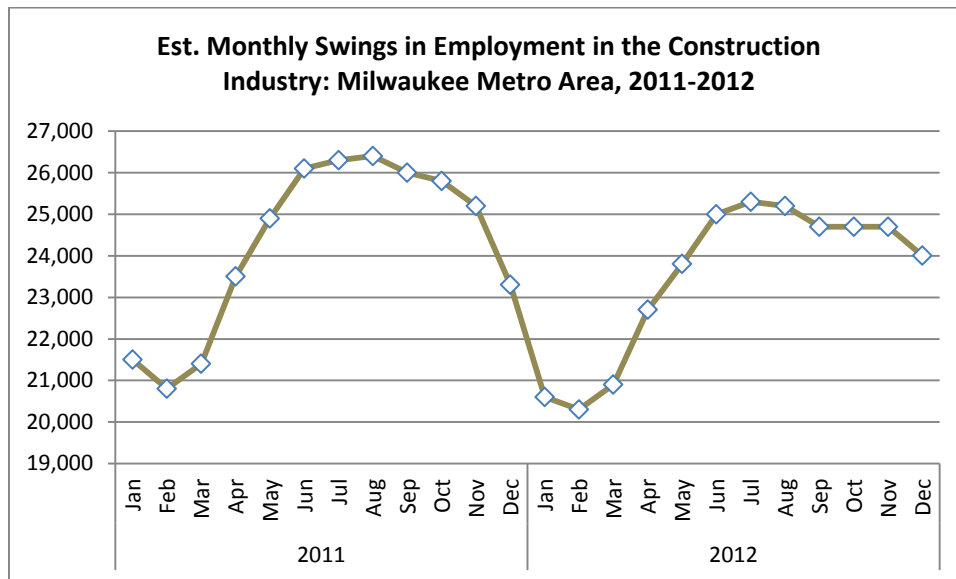


¹ The 2013 apprenticeship data for 15 union joint apprenticeship committees and for the ABC of WI-Waukesha Joint Apprenticeship Committee are as of April 29, 2013. The 2013 data for the Southern Wisconsin Heat & Frost Insulators JAC and the statewide Wisconsin Operating Engineers JAC are as of July 24, 2013. All of the apprenticeship data reported for 2010 are as of the month of January 2010, and all of the data reported for 2007 are as of the month of September 2007. The 2005 data are for the month of September 2005, except for the Wisconsin Operating Engineers JAC whose data are for October 2005.

In the four-county Milwaukee area (i.e., Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Washington and Waukesha counties) the estimated number of workers employed by construction firms dropped from highs of 37,900 in July and August of 2007 to 20,300 in February 2012.



The graph below shows the monthly changes in employment levels of Milwaukee area construction firms over the 24-month period from January 2011 through December 2012.



This is the fourth report card tracking apprentices in the construction trades. The data are provided to:

- Assist the NAACP's Labor and Industry Committee in its work promoting economic opportunities for African Americans and other minorities in Milwaukee.
- Indicate whether adequate numbers of young workers are being trained as skilled trades workers reach retirement age.
- Help assess whether governmental financial support is needed for increased construction trade apprenticeship training.
- Measure the impacts of the national recession and housing crisis on apprenticeship training in the construction trades and enrollments of African Americans, Latinos, Native Americans and Asians in training programs.
- Measure whether any improvements have been made in the number of women receiving apprenticeship training.
- Gauge the extent to which the Department of Workforce Development is effectively promoting and enforcing state affirmative action requirements for apprentices.
- Help assess the impact of the governor's rescission of the state requirement for apprenticeship training on state-funded construction contracts.

Summary

1. Sixty-five African Americans and 53 Hispanics are being trained in union construction trade apprenticeship programs in the Milwaukee area. (See pp. 5-25.)
2. Ten African Americans and 16 Hispanics are being trained in non-union construction trade apprenticeship programs in the Milwaukee area. (See pp. 30-33.)
3. Statewide, only 9 African Americans and 3 Hispanics are training as operating engineering apprentices. (See pp. 27-29.)
4. Women are underrepresented in all of the apprenticeship programs reviewed. Eighteen women are receiving apprenticeship training in union companies in the Milwaukee area and only one woman is receiving apprenticeship training in the non-union companies. (See pp. 26, 32.)

Note: Apprenticeship totals are as of April 2013, except for operating engineer and heat and frost insulator apprenticeship which are as of July 2013.

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Part One: Union Apprentices Sponsored by Milwaukee Area Construction Trade Joint Apprenticeship Committees

The number of construction trade apprentices being trained in the Milwaukee area is down significantly given the negative impacts of the national recession and the housing foreclosure crises on the construction industry. The number of African American apprentices receiving training dropped by 66% from 191 in September 2007 to 65 in April 2013. The number of white apprentices dropped by 64% from 1,440 in September 2007 to 517 in April 2013.

The largest number of apprentices are sponsored by the Milwaukee Area Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee (N=14) and the Southeast Wisconsin Area Carpentry JAC (N=10). Twelve of the JACs showed declines in the number of African American apprentices since 2007.

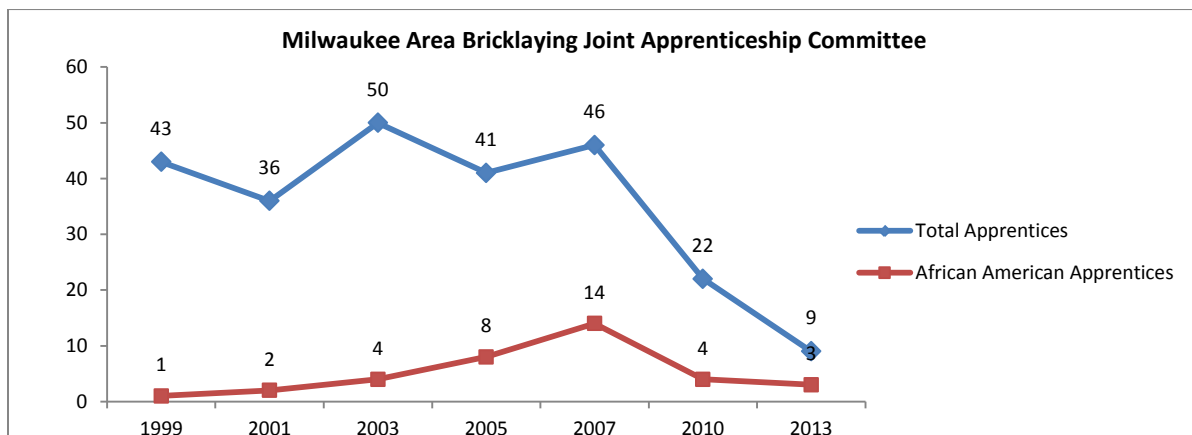
The number of companies sponsoring apprentices (of any race/ethnicity) dropped from 313 in January 2010 to 217 this year.

Milwaukee Area Bricklaying Joint Apprenticeship Committee

Three African Americans and 2 Hispanics were receiving apprenticeship training as bricklayers as of April 2013. These minorities made up 56% of the apprentices.

The Milwaukee Area Bricklaying Joint Apprenticeship Committee reported 9 apprentices as of April 2013, down from 50 in March 2003 and 46 in September 2007 before the recession.

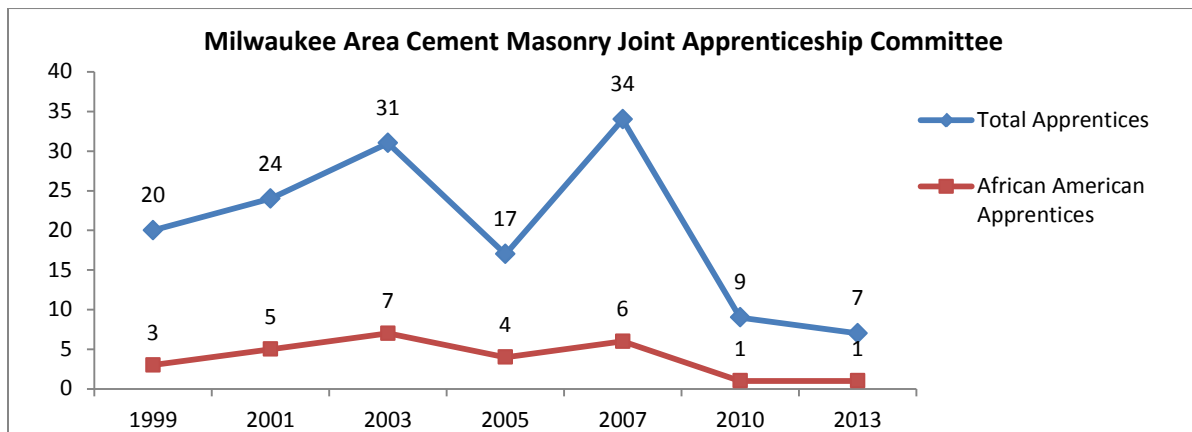

One firm (T V John & Son) had an African American cement mason apprentice, and 1 firm (Elastizell of Wisconsin) had a Hispanic apprentice.

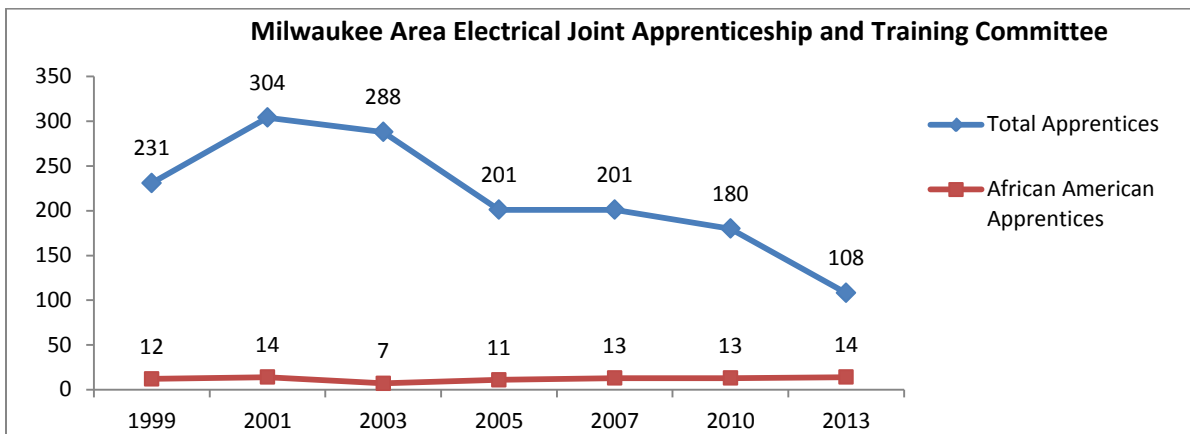

The most minority electrician apprentices are being trained by Pieper Electric (with 4 African Americans and 1 Hispanic), Hurt Electric (with 2 African American, 1 Hispanic, and 1 Asian apprentice), and Uihlein Electric (with 1 Hispanic and 2 Asian apprentices).

By contrast, all 19 of the apprentices with Staff Electric were whites.

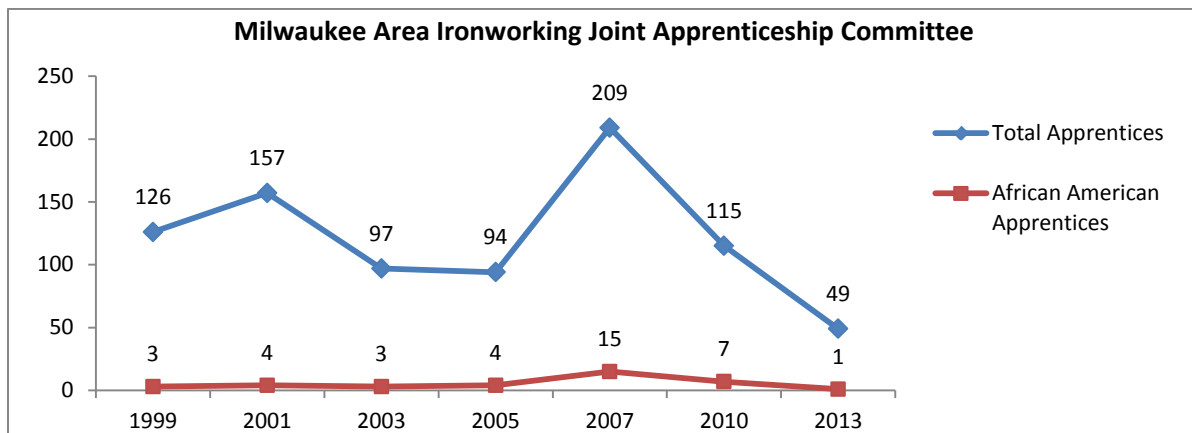

Only 1 firm (Bechtel Construction) had an African American training as an iron worker apprentice. Six firms (A & A Electric, Area Erectors, Capitol Steel Erectors, Choice Construction, International Erectors, and Red Cedar Steel Erectors) each had 1 Hispanic apprentice, and SPE had 1 Asian apprentice. The most iron worker apprentices were employed by Doral Corporation; all 8 of their apprentices were whites.

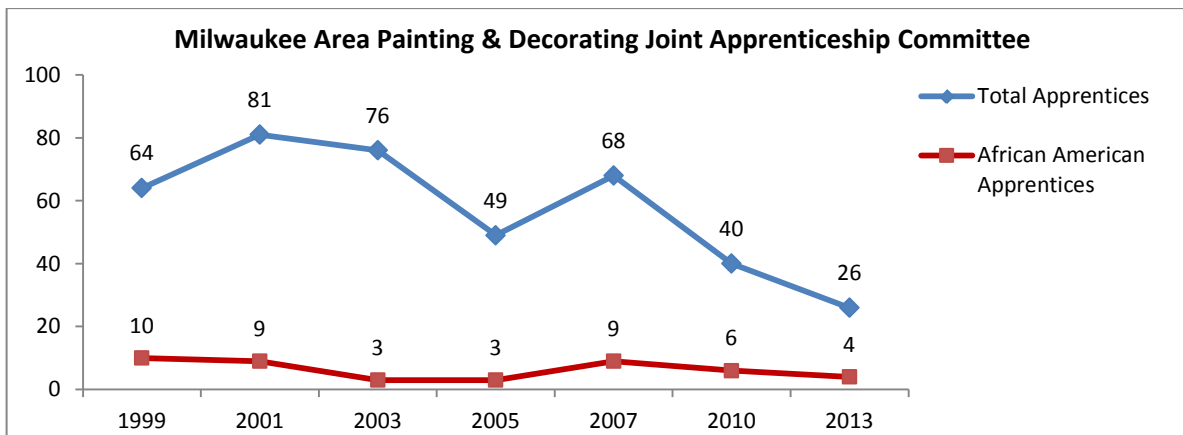

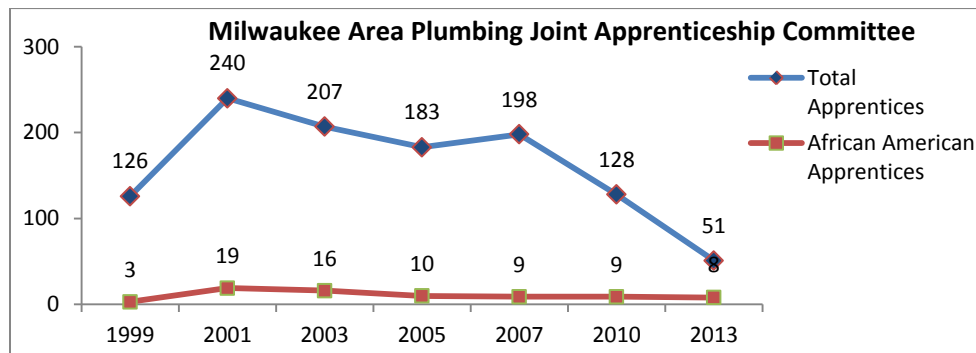

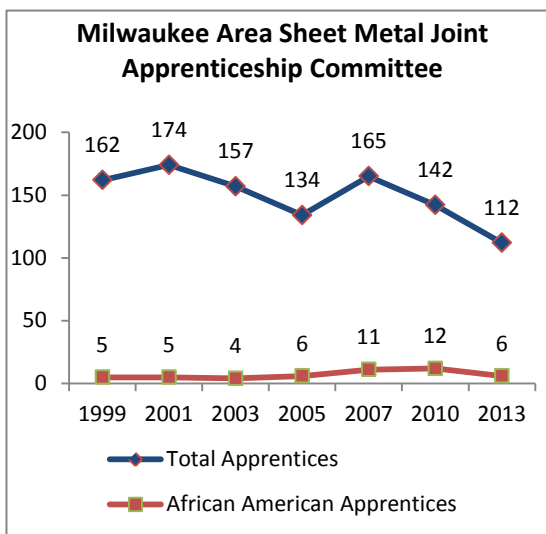

The apprenticeship totals include 80 sheet metal workers, 2 sheet metal workers (residential), and 30 environmental technicians.

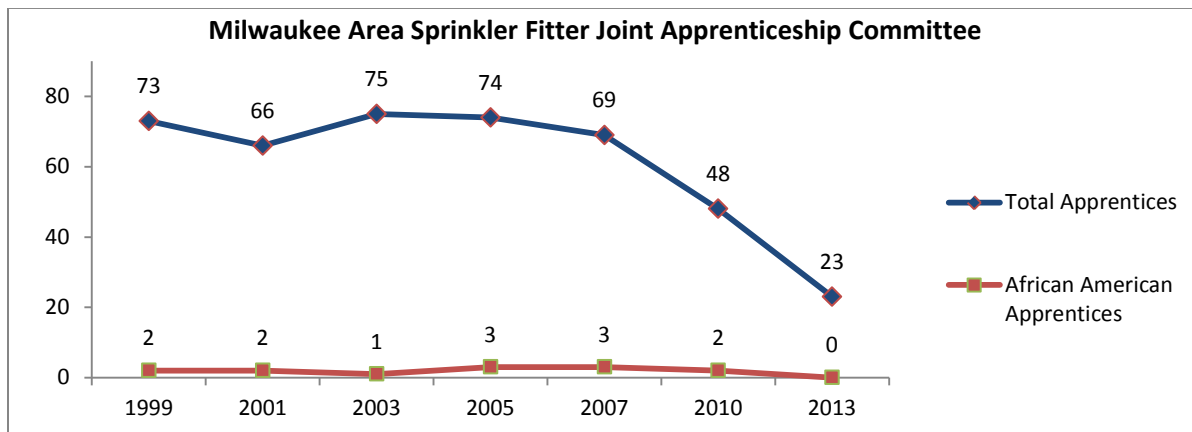

Milwaukee Area Sprinkler Fitter Joint Apprenticeship Committee

The sprinkler fitter JAC had NO African Americans being trained in apprenticeship programs in the Milwaukee area as of April 2013. All 23 of the sprinklerfitter apprentices were white.

The total number of apprentices receiving training has dropped from 74 in September 2005 to 23 this year.

Wisconsin Operating Engineers Joint Apprenticeship Committee - Statewide

The operating engineers apprenticeship program is sponsored by a statewide joint apprenticeship committee, which reported 294 apprentices employed at 120 companies as of July 2013. The number of operating engineer apprentices statewide dropped from 560 in 2007 to under 300 in 2013, and the number of African American apprentices dropped from 20 to 9. African Americans hold 3% of the apprentices, Native Americans 3%, and Hispanics 1%.

Statewide, of the 120 companies with operating engineer apprentices in April 2013, 118 had white apprentices.

Only 9 companies in the state were training an African American operating engineer apprentice: Babcock & Wilcox, Capitol Underground, Corevac, H. James and Sons, James Peterson Sons, Layne Christensen, Payne & Dolan, Super Western, and Zenith Tech.

Three firms each had 1 Hispanic operating engineer apprentice: Integrity Grading & Excavating, Oscar J. Boldt Construction, and Zenith Tech.

Edward Kramer & Sons has 2 Native American operating engineering apprentices, and 6 firms each had 1: Arrow-Crete Construction, Cornerstone Pavers, H. James & Sons, Miron Construction, Schneider Excavating, and St. Joseph Contracting.

Mathy Construction Company was the only firm in the state with an Asian operating engineer apprentice.

Very few African Americans were sponsored for operating engineer apprentices in Wisconsin in 2010 or in 2013. In January 2010 (when the last report card was issued), of 174 companies with operating engineer apprentices, only 13 firms had African American apprentices (with a total of 20 sponsored). In April 2013 of 120 companies with operating engineer apprentices, only 9 firms each had 1 African American apprentice. Payne and Dolan was the only company in the state with an African American operating engineer apprentice in both January 2010 and April 2013.

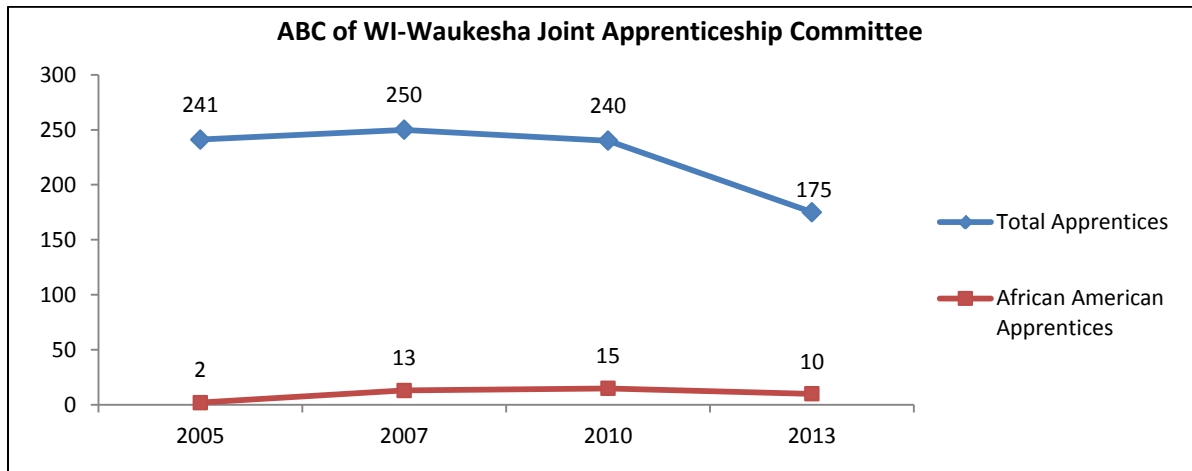

Background on the Apprenticeship Program

Apprenticeships in Wisconsin are regulated by state statute and involve written contracts between the apprentice, the sponsoring joint apprenticeship committee, and the State of Wisconsin. All participating employers are required to take affirmative steps to provide equal employment opportunity in apprenticeships. Joint apprenticeship committees are required to adopt annual affirmative action plans for identifying, recruiting, and training present and potential minority and female apprentices, and if failing to meet their prior year's hiring goals for minorities and women, required to evaluate their prior "good faith" efforts and make changes to improve the effectiveness of their programs.

Construction contractors receiving federal funding, including stimulus funds under the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, are obligated to meet affirmative action provisions contained in Executive Order 11246, with enforcement through the U.S. Department of Labor Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP).

In 2010 the Wisconsin Legislative Audit Bureau identified a number of shortcomings and failures by the Department of Workforce Development to enforce affirmative action requirements for minorities and women in construction trade apprentices.
