If you meet UWM standard admission requirements, you will be admitted directly into the [Peck School of the Arts](#) Pre-Art program. Incoming freshman and transfer students are required to submit a portfolio.

Application Deadline Dates:

Fall- January 15

Spring- November 15

Students applying after the Application Deadline may be considered on a space available basis.
