### **Application Deadline Dates:**

Fall- January 15

Spring- November 15

For this program, you are encouraged to transfer to UWM after three or four semesters at a UWC campus. Course work required for entry into the major is not available at a UWC campus. It is possible to be concurrently enrolled at a UWC and at UWM. Concurrent enrollment would allow you to take the required courses for your major at UWM while finishing up other course work at a UWC.
