

General Education Requirements (GER):

The UWM B.S. degree includes the following general education requirements:

Fine Arts	8 cr.
Humanities	12 cr.
Natural Science	15 cr.
Social Science	9 cr.

Students transferring General Education Courses from WTCS to UWM may transfer a maximum of 15 credits of General Education, Communication, Behavioral Science, and Social Science courses, provided the courses fit UWM degree requirements for the core curriculum. In addition, Students may transfer a total of two courses from the Math and/or Natural Science areas, if the courses were taken September 1995 or later.

Additionally, appropriate course work may be applied to cultural diversity & WI Act 31 requirements.

The maximum number of credits that can be transferred from collegiate transfer institutions to UWM is **72**.

Additional Conditions :

1. Acceptance into the UWM professional program is based upon academic and non-academic criteria determined by the Department of Curriculum and Instruction.
2. The UWM baccalaureate candidate must also meet UWM's General Education and Cultural Diversity Requirements.
3. Program to Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the degree specified in this agreement. A change of major invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other Program to Program Articulation Agreement for a different major at UWM.
4. Course equivalencies specified in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the course curriculum of the WTCS Early Childhood Program or UWM undergoes revision.

5. Degree must be posted on official transcript to receive credits from the agreement.

6. Admission to UWM does NOT guarantee admission to the professional program in the UWM School of Education. To be eligible to apply for admission to the School of Education professional program students must meet the following conditions:
 1. Completion of 58 degree credits (transferable WTCS plus UWM credits).
 2. 2.5 cumulative grade point average on transferable credits (it must be emphasized that 2.5 GPA is the minimum and does not guarantee acceptance into the professional program).
 3. The School of Education admission requirements:
 - a. Preprofessional Skills Test (PPST scores of 175 in reading, 173 in Math, 174 in Writing).
 - b. English Composition Requirement: Grade of C or better in UWM Eng. 102 or equivalent WTCS course.
 - c. Mathematics: passing score on UWM Math 105, 106, 109 or 175 or equivalent WTCS course.
 - d. Communications Proficiency by taking UWM Communication 101 or 103 or WTCS equivalent.

This agreement is effective July 1, 2001 and will apply to students who complete a WTCS Early Childhood Education A.A.S. degree after that date.
