

# **FRESHMAN SCHOLARS PROGRAM ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

## **Purpose**

The Freshman Scholars Program (FSP) Advisory Committee provides advice and counsel to the Director of the FSP and, where appropriate, to the Dean on general policies, objectives, and programs as well as on budgetary issues that may arise. The Committee receives regular reports and input from the individuals responsible for administering various aspects of the program (see below) in order to help the Director set policy and direction for the FSP.

## **Membership**

The Advisory Committee is composed of the following individuals as voting members:

- the faculty member responsible for faculty development
- the faculty member responsible for program assessment
- a faculty member from the humanities who has taught a freshman seminar
- a faculty member from the natural sciences who has taught a freshman seminar
- a faculty member from the social sciences who has taught a freshman seminar
- two L&S advisors
- two students who have taken freshman seminars

The Advisory Committee also has the following ex-officio members:

- the Associate Dean for curricular matters
- the FSP Director
- the assistant to the FSP Director
- a representative from the Provost's office

## **Terms of Membership**

Voting members are appointed by the Dean in June to serve a one-year term beginning July 1. There is no restriction on reappointment of Committee members. The Program Director in consultation with the Advisory Committee may make recommendations to the Dean for Committee memberships each year.

## **Committee Chair**

The Program Director will be responsible for calling the first meeting of the Committee each year. At that meeting, a Committee chair will be elected to serve for the year. Any voting member of the Committee other than the Director or his/her assistant is eligible to serve as Committee chair.
