The site allows users to view **authors** and **illustrators** as they speak about the making of their books, hear audio excerpts of professional **book readings**, and search for **themed book lists** and **book guides**; many, complete with discussion questions and **classroom activities**.

Finding Materials

Teachingbooks.net allows you to search or browse for information. The simple search feature is located in the upper right corner of the page. An author, title, or keyword search can be done from the simple search. The advanced search button can be found in the top navigation bar. The advanced search allows you to limit by grade levels and subject area.

To browse the collection, simply click on one of the links for Author Programs, Book Guides, Book Readings, or Author Websites.
