

COPYING TO A CD-ROM ON THE LAPTOP

- 1) Save your file(s) to the Local Disk D: drive for temporary use. **NOTE: When computer is shut down this drive erases itself.**
- 2) Insert CD-ROM disk in disk drive.
- 3) Double-Click on the Nero Burning icon.
- 4) Click on **CONTINUE Multisession Disc**. NOTE: If this is the first time you saved to this cd-rom disc Choose **START Multisession Disc** instead.
- 5) Click on New.
- 6) Click on Ok.
- 7) Click on Local Disk D: in File Browser column.
- 8) In the far right column, Right-Click on the name of the file you want to copy.
- 9) Click Copy to Compilation to move it to the compilation list.
- 10) Click on the Burn icon located in the tool bar (it is a picture of a cd-rom with a match on it)
OR
Click on **Recorder** and then **Burn Compilation**.
- 11) Click on Burn.
- 12) File(s) will be burned/copied to the cd-rom.
- 13) Click on **Ok** when it is done copying.
- 14) Click on **DONE**. The CD-ROM will eject.
- 15) Close the Nero Burning software window.
- 16) Click on “No” to save ISO changes.
