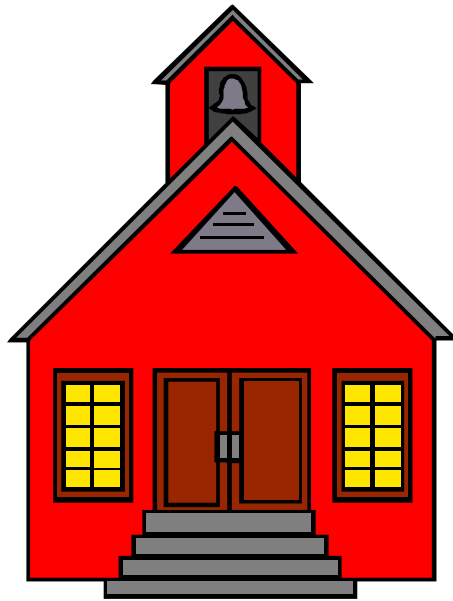

## INTRODUCTION

The *Guide to Selected Holdings in the Golda Meir Library Relating to the Work of Dorothy Caroline Enderis* was produced in October 1998 as part of the 29th Annual Morris Fromkin Memorial Lecture at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee's Golda Meir Library. The *Guide* entries were found by searching the Golda Meir Library's online catalog for items on subjects such as "Community centers," "Playgrounds," and "Education--United States," and reformatting the results.

The guide is divided into three sections. The first section (pages 1-4) lists monographs found in the Morris Fromkin Memorial Collection (located in room W250); the second section (pages 5-6) lists materials found in both the Archives (room W250) and in the Library's general stacks; and the third section (page 7) lists searchable subjects and names which may be used to further explore the Golda Meir Library's holdings in the online catalog.
