

Tips to Using Turning Point

- Test your presentation using simulated data before using in class
- Have your students program their channel each lecture (e.g., GO 73)
- Make sure that you have only *one* presentation open at any time; close down the default presentation that opens when TP is opened
- Run your presentation off of the hard drive not your flash
- Make sure to import and load your participant list
- Do not add your own graphics (clip art, for instance) to TP slides, unless absolutely necessary
- Use fewer "customizations" if your presentation seems to be running slow
- If you are animating your non-interactive PPT slides, do NOT extend that animation to your TP slides
- Smaller files seem to work better than larger ones
- Be cautious when cutting and pasting slides between presentations (test before using)
- When clicking for the next slide to appear, it takes about 5 seconds for the polling to open, so don't click again...
- Be patient ☺
