

## Minutes for Black and Gold: November 14, 2011

1. Call to order: Heather Hermus called the meeting to order at 12:04pm.

5. Survey for Tuition Differential:
  - a. Update on Survey Monkey-Mandy Sheriff: Mandy found out that Survey Monkey is very easy to use. - a. Update on funds available: No updates available at this time.

December 13, 2011 someone will come to set up the Sim Man as well as have a two day orientation for some of the staff.
