1. Determination of who will take minutes for the upcoming meetings were determined.
2. Student Representatives: Staff nominate/ask students to serve on Black and Gold committee

4. Student survey: (Jennifer Daood) Themes were developed after review from the surveys conducted in Fall 2003.
 - a. Parkside students dislike condensed classes (3-4 hour blocks), rather have classes two times per week
 - b. Biochemistry (Chem 103) will now be offered in the summer at UWM
 - c. Priority Registration: Not an issue controlled by CON, attempts to meet current legislative regulation of 165 credits and out (or else pay full cost out of pocket)
 - d. Clinical: Students want more rotations, more options for course selection
 - i. Learn by practice, not observation
 - e. Jennifer Gammeter will write up an "Issue of the Month" in response to survey report
5. Black and Gold flyer made by Liz Kozub; will go under further revisions and then be posted around Cunningham
6. Ken Lyman explained his progress in instituting a healthy food alternative to students, staff, and faculty in Cunningham.
 - a. Requirements: Space, access to hand washing, access to electrical outlets

 - c. Issue taken to Dean of CON, willing to do site visit with final approval
 - i. Issue will now be worked out with CON business affairs, not the Black and Gold committee
