2. Minutes of December 13, 2010 meeting, **approved**
3. CON Black and Gold membership updates:
 - a. Recruiting/elections/resignations-

4. Review Tuition Differential updates
 - 2010-2011 total funds
 - Anticipated available funds for NLRC \$173,500
 - Projected recurring NLRC expenditures \$101,433

 - Reviewed Potential Purchases for the NLRC
 - Discussed other future expenses with large price tag ie.. Computers in NLRC (uwm & uwp) need replacing and first generation simulators (whose lifetime use is past due).
 - Discussed support of Clinical Faculty and Student Services line (\$83,500 and \$93,000). University regulations allow this
 - UWP: Updates on Student study area. Discussed getting a proposal together using Badger Furniture. Sue Dean-Baar will then discuss proposal with UWP campus due to Consortial agreement. Students remain very excited.
 - Sue Dean-Baar shared that the UWP printer issue has been remedied. The unit is now being rented.
 - Color Printer cost at UWM versus Color printer cost in the community **will be tabled** until March meeting.
5. Projects/ Social Activities update for 2011
 - A. UWP: SNAP Update
The annual GALA is on March 4th, 2011 at the Roma Lodge in Racine. The agency chosen for support is the March of Dimes. Students are very excited and encourage the UWM student sand Faculty to come. There is a silent auction with Packer autographed items just to name a few.
