The UWM Bands perform a diverse and exciting repertoire that includes music for chamber and full symphonic ensembles, and features the great masterworks as well as new works by today's most prolific composers.

Wind Ensemble

The Wind Ensemble is a select ensemble of the most accomplished wind and percussion students in the Department of Music. This group stresses the single performer concept, utilizing only the players needed for a given piece, and thus providing the greatest exposure to the exceptional musician. As a preeminent ensemble, the Wind Ensemble has performed at numerous national, regional, and state conferences. The Wind Ensemble can be heard on a series of compact disc recordings, *Classics for Wind Ensemble and Symphony Band, Volumes 1-4*.

Symphony Band

The Symphony Band performs repertoire for full wind band instrumentation, drawn from standard and contemporary concert band works, and is primarily made up of undergraduate music majors. Throughout its history, Symphony Band has performed with a number of distinguished composers including John Corigliano, Joseph Schwantner, Karel Husa, Samuel Adler, Warren Benson, Fisher Tull, Anthony Iannoccone and David Holsinger.

University Band

The University Band is open to all graduate and undergraduate students at UWM, and brings together students from all academic disciplines, including music, who wish to continue playing during their college careers. University Band is conducted by graduate conducting associates as part of their studies for the Master in Music degree in conducting.

Scott R. Corley

Interim Director of Bands

Scott R. Corley directs all aspects of the University Bands program at UWM, and serves as the primary conductor of the Wind Ensemble and Youth Wind Ensemble II. A native of South Carolina, he received his Bachelor of Music from the University of South Carolina and his Master of Music (Conducting) from the University of Georgia. He has taught in the public schools of Greenville, South Carolina as well as at UWM, and has served as a guest conductor/clinician in the Southeast, and in Wisconsin. Mr. Corley has performed with the UGA Wind Symphony and Georgia Brass, and was co-director/conductor of the Georgia Ambassadors of Music European Tour in 2001. In 2004, Mr. Corley and the UWM Youth Wind Ensemble II were featured performers at the Cantando International Music Festival in Edmonton, Alberta, and in 2006 he conducted on the UWM Wind Ensemble program at the CBDNA North-Central Divisional Conference at Northwestern University.



Scott A. Jones

Interim Assistant Director of Bands

Scott A. Jones directs the Symphony Band, Panther (Basketball) Band, and supervises the University Band. He is active in all administrative aspects of the Band program including leadership in the Honors Band and Concert Band Festivals, supervision of band staff and librarians, and recruitment and retention of ensemble personnel. Mr. Jones holds two Master of Music degrees, one in Instrumental Conducting from UWM, under the guidance of Professor Emeritus Thomas Dvorak, and one in Saxophone Performance from The Peabody Institute of The Johns Hopkins University, studying under Gary Louie. He earned his Bachelor of Music from Grand Valley State University. Mr. Jones has held teaching or conducting positions with the Milwaukee Youth Symphony Orchestra, Morgan State University, Maryland Conservatory of Music, The Peabody Preparatory and The Highlands School (Maryland).
