UWM WINTER INTERSESSION

“UWinteriM” is an offering of accelerated courses scheduled during interim break, January 2-18, 2013. UWinteriM lets you earn up to three degree credits over the break.

DATES TO REMEMBER	
October 8	Approximate date the Schedule of Classes will appear on PAWS and online Approximate date UWinteriM registration appointment times for all eligible continuing, reentering and new students will appear on PAWS
October 15-19	UWinteriM priority registration by appointment via PAWS. Student appointment/start time will be based on level (year-in-school).
October 20	Beginning of UWinteriM open enrollment period via PAWS. PAWS will generally be available for registration Monday-Saturday, 6:00 a.m. to midnight and Sundays from noon to midnight, except holidays.
December 27	Deadline for full payment of fees for UWinteriM classes. Failure to pay may result in an assessment of a \$25 late fee. Last day to drop from UWinteriM without charge or for full refund
January 2	End of UWinteriM registration via PAWS. Any adds after this date require instructor approval on add forms. First day of UWinteriM classes. Students registering on or after January 2 will be assessed a \$50 late registration fee.
January 4	Last day to drop without owing full tuition for UWinteriM classes
January 9	Last day to drop three-week classes that began January 2
January 18	Last day of the UWinteriM 2013 term
January 22	Priority date UWinteriM grades must be entered and approved by instructors on PAWS

Registration

UWinteriM registration will take place between October 15, 2012 and January 2, 2013. Students should register using the PAWS system. Check your PAWS Student Center for your enrollment appointment, the date/time on or after which you are eligible to register. The system will generally be available for registration from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., 7 days a week except Sunday mornings. The system may not be available November 22, December 24, 25, 30, 31 or January 1.

Students are limited to a maximum of (3) credits. **Audits will not be allowed in many UWinteriM classes.**

Class Time Conflicts/Overlaps

Students must obtain, in advance, the instructor’s approval via an add/drop form to enroll in classes which have any time conflict or overlap.

Late Registration, Adds, Drops and Withdrawals

Note: There will be no transcript notation (“W” grade) for UWinteriM drops.

¹ Some departments will not sign adds on behalf of the instructors. Check with the department in advance of the deadline. Students who add courses after the first meeting date are encouraged to contact the instructor prior to enrolling to discuss ramifications for missed work or instruction. Changes to or from credit/no credit status do not require signatures up to the add deadline.

UWinteriM Schedule and Snow Dates

UWinteriM classes are for a maximum of 13 class days, January 2-18, 2013. (WRF, MTWRF, MTWRF).



Snow dates: In the event that the University must cancel classes due to a snow emergency, make-up sessions are pre-planned for Saturday, January 5, 2013 (for the week of 1/2); Saturday, January 12, 2013 (for the week of 1/7); Saturday, January 19, 2013 (for the week of 1/14). Instructors may select alternate snow-day makeup policies and publish them in their syllabi.

Fee Schedule and Policies

UWinteriM is a separate term for purposes of tuition and enrollment verification. Enrollment in UWinteriM will not count toward full-time or part-time status for either the fall or spring semesters.

The Bursar will bill students separately for UWinteriM courses. Students who were enrolled in the fall semester and who paid their segregated fees along with their fall semester tuition will be able to use campus services supported by those fees (e.g. Norris Health Center, UPASS, etc.) during UWinteriM. Students who did not pay segregated fees during the fall semester, or who were not enrolled in fall, will not be eligible to use these facilities.

Students who drop UWinteriM classes by December 27 will not be assessed fees for these classes. Students who drop after December 27, but no later than January 4, will be assessed a \$50 withdrawal fee. For drops after January 4, there will be no reduction in fee obligation. Full tuition will be due.

Fees for all UWinteriM classes are due by December 27, 2012.

Parking during UWinteriM

The following permits will be available for purchase at the Parking and Transit Office (Union WG25), beginning approximately December 26, 2012, to students with proof of UWinteriM registration.

\$30: Permit valid for 14 days of guaranteed daytime parking in the Union garage.

\$20: Permit valid daytime hours at any pay station parking space in the Sandburg, EMS, and Pavilion (Klotsche) garages, as well as the Cunningham and Sciences surface lots. This permit is valid for nighttime parking.

The Fall 2012 UPASS is also valid during UWinteriM using your fall UPASS. UPARK shuttles will **NOT** operate during UWinteriM.
